



NIMS TRAINING & EXERCISES COMPLIANCE TEMPLATE 2006

NIMS compliance for 2006 builds on the basic elements of 2005 compliance but differs significantly in that particular levels of training are required for specific groups of persons. The below template reflects only the local government and state agency training and exercise requirements identified in the 2006 NIMS compliance guidance. Other elements are required to be fully NIMS compliant; see Notes.

ICS training sponsored by the Emergency Management Institute, National Fire Academy, National Wildfire Coordinating Group, U.S. Department of Agriculture, Environmental Protection Agency, and U.S. Coast Guard follows the DHS model. ICS training conducted under the authority of the state agencies whose logos appear on Page One and are listed below meets the DHS standard.
- Completion of Basic ICS (IS 195, V 200, or V 190) meets the learning objectives of both ICS 100 and ICS 200.
